

## All-Source intelligence analyst

Research and produce all-source counterterrorism studies and products. Conduct research and analysis of all-source data, populate databases, and disseminate a broad array of intelligence products to senior U.S. government and DoD audiences. Produce intelligence products on personalities involved in terrorist activities to include their operational capabilities, internal security, organizational facilities, and tactics, techniques, and procedures (TTP) in order to support national-level counterterrorism planning and operational missions.

### **Required Skills:**

Bachelor or Master's degree with 4-6 years of intelligence analysis experience, or specialized training and 4-8 years of intelligence analysis experience, or equivalent intelligence/academic experience. A minimum of one-year counterterrorism experience is preferred.

The successful candidate must have experience-producing original all source analysis from unevaluated classified data by fusing all major intelligence disciplines (HUMINT, SIGINT, IMINT, etc.). Candidate must have a working knowledge of Intelligence Community reporting methods (TD, TDX, IIR, TIR, etc.). Candidate must also have experience with a message handling system (RMT/M3/Tripwire, etc.) and MS Office suite.

### **Preferred Skills:**

Working knowledge of: counterterrorism analysis, Analyst Notebook, Palantir or other spatial tools; JWICS analytic tools (ICReach, ArcGIS, etc.); familiarity with customer's finished intelligence products; working knowledge of DNI analytic sourcing and excellent analytic writing standards; deployment experience- both Afghanistan and Iraq; experience providing support to Special Operations Forces (SOF).
